

Based on examining the structures of the North American Inter-Fraternity Conference, the National Panhellenic Conference and the National Pan-Hellenic Council, the committee members have chosen to adapt the following structure for the National Association of Latino Fraternal Organizations. The NALFO membership will adopt the following Standards of Ethical Conduct Agreement, which will serve as the foundation to promote and foster positive interfraternal relations, communication, and development of all Latino Fraternal organizations.

**Standards of Ethical Conduct Agreement:**

The concepts, comments and suggestions in these documents are not necessarily original, but nevertheless, they are presented in an effort to promote consistency throughout NALFO as we carry out various functions and seek to enhance our Greek family, as well as, our own personal image. In these times of rapidly changing values and lifestyle, it is imperative that we, who know better, exercise a high level of decorum, mutual respect and courtesy.

1. NALFO organizations shall impress upon their undergraduate and alumnae members that they shall respect and obey the letter and the spirit of all NALFO Standards of Ethical Conduct.
2. In case of fraternal difficulties, all chapters involved shall attempt to restore harmony and to prevent negative publicity, both in the college and the community.
3. NALFO organizations shall not approach any potential member(s) who has indicated a preference for a particular organization other than theirs with a proposal to have the potential member(s) refuse the organization.
4. It is in accord with the dignity and good manners of fraternal organizations: to avoid disparaging remarks about other college students, non-fraternal organizations, or other Greek-lettered organizations; to create friendly relations between fraternal and non-fraternal students, and to publicize only those things which are dignified, worthwhile and uplifting.

**LIABILITY:**

As self-determining and self-governing organizations, the NALFO membership is responsible for their actions on a group and individual member basis, locally, regionally and nationally. NALFO is not responsible for actions of local councils or individual council members who aid in violation of both the letter and the spirit of the Standards of Ethical Conduct, Constitution and Bylaws.
