
### National Communication System

Dear Brothers,

Universities, state and federal health officials are actively monitoring the outbreak of respiratory illness caused by a novel (new) coronavirus that was first detected in Wuhan City, China. Very rapidly spreading, the virus has been detected in numerous countries including the United States. Due to the increase in confirmed cases in the US, several states have declared a state of emergency, including New York, New Jersey, Florida, California, North Carolina, Indiana, and many more. It is believed that many more states will join this list. Many universities, colleges and schools are also taking action to suspend classes or conduct them remotely until further notice.

Our nation's current health care system cannot support this growing outbreak. The chart below provides some clarity to this pandemic:

In response to the new information and the seriousness of this pandemic, The National Board has decided to move all intake activities to virtual mode effective immediately. No face to face interaction is permitted during this time until this restriction is lifted. The National Cacique Mayor will provide more detailed instructions to the RCMs and caciques. **This situation is very fluid and the National Board will adjust our response as more information comes in, if needed. The safety of our brothers and prospective members is our number one priority and this decision was not made lightly.**
